


## Accessing and Using Purple Mash – Felton C of E First School

These documents can then be saved and then accessed in their <b>Online Docs</b>. If children choose to share their work, it will be screened, approved and sent to the <b>Display Board</b>.</p>
	<p>This is where you'll find a whole host of fascinating software to try out and fall in love with. Anything you program or create here can be saved in their <b>Online Docs</b>. Painting, coding, animating, composing, tabulating – you name it, it's here with progressive lessons and helpful videos.</p>
