We are currently hoping to have a more permanent solution to our heating issues next week and will of course let you all know as soon as we have this confirmed. In the meantime, please continue to send children in lots of extra warm clothes and with as many snacks as you wish - thank you!

Unbelievably next week will be the last of the half term and I am sure, like us, you are all ready for a break from the pressures of juggling work and home learning. I can only hope that the second half of term provides some more positive news and we can all be together in school again very soon
