Use of Pupil Premium Funding 2015-16

The Government allocates extra money to schools in the form of Pupil Premium Funding to raise the attainment of children in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM) and to close the gap in attainment between FSM students and non FSM pupils.

Due to the current numbers of students eligible for pupil premium funding we have been allocated the following amount for the financial Year 2015 -16:

PUPIL PREMIUM ALLOCATION

In line with our School Development Plan to raise attainment for all pupils; we have allocated the following funding for April 2014 – April 2015 to the following areas:

1. Numeracy intervention training and assessment tools

Support Staff will attend training on a targeted maths intervention programme in the Summer Term designed to a) close the gaps in attainment for those children identified as requiring early intervention and additional support in Numeracy

Cost £750

2. Additional hours for TA support

Funding has allowed us to maintain our relatively high levels of teaching assistant support in school, allowing small group support for children in class rooms and also in activities such as our communication group

Contribution towards cost of £4350 (Actual Cost £5161)

3. Provision of Free Breakfast Club places

We currently run a breakfast club which focusses on social an emotional development in a small nurturing environment which allows children to prepare for the day in school and builds self-confidence and esteem

Contribution towards cost 1,000 (Actual cost £2742)

4. Support for curriculum enrichment activities

As we believe that developing the whole child is key to them achieving their potential we ensure that all children have the opportunity to attend a residential in years 3 and 4 and are given the opportunity to take part in after school clubs as appropriate
