We have all been practising our throwing skills using bean bags and hoops for a target. In maths, Reception have been learning about odd and even numbers through lots of practical activities and a very special rhyme that helps us to remember the pattern of odd and even, We wonder if they can recall this for you? This adventure has caught our imaginations and we have lots more play and learning to enjoy!
