<p>Make a collection of sticks that are different lengths to represent snakes. Order them according to length, use the language short, shortest, long, longest.</p> <p>Repeat the above activity using a variety of socks from your household.</p> <p>Use 1p's - make a mini shop, price the items all under 5p. Describe them using adjectives and name the parts of their bodies. You could annotate what your child says.</p> <p>Use the following link to develop your child's concentration and listening skills - Key vocabulary: <i>jungle, monkey, elephant, lion</i>.            Sound discrimination: Cat invites the listeners to guess the sounds of <i>an elephant trumpeting, a lion roaring and a monkey chattering</i>. You could use natural materials (good one for using your garden) or you could draw, paint, collage using mediums of your choice.</p> <p>Make a rainmaker using a tube. Fill with one of the following - rice, pasta, dried beans/peas. Then decorate.</p> <p>Have fun moving like the animals in the book.
