

Journey further.....into WW2 and Propaganda

Here are some activities that will support your child's learning journey this half term. A minimum of one of these is to be completed this term and can be submitted at any time to receive 5 team points. The work will be presented to the class and displayed in school.

Create a timeline of key events from WW2. You could label your with words or pictures to represent dates and key events.

Research the work of Henry Moore. He was most famous for his beautiful sculptures but he also sketched depictions of ordinary people during his time sheltering from German bombs in the London Underground. You could try to emulate how he drew figures or how he used perspective to show how long the tunnels were.

Research the impact of the war on a particular group of people. For example children (evacuees) or women (Land Army).

Design and create an air raid shelter.

Create a wartime rationing recipe. Try making your recipe and evaluating how different/similar wartime mealtimes may be to your own today.

Design and create an air raid shelter.

Learn and perform a wartime song for the class.

Create your own propaganda poster to encourage people to: stick to rationing rules, dig for victory or make do and mend.

Create a biography for a significant person involved in WW2.

Be creative in the way you present your work it can be on the computer, handwritten, photographed or even a video. Most importantly....ENJOY!
